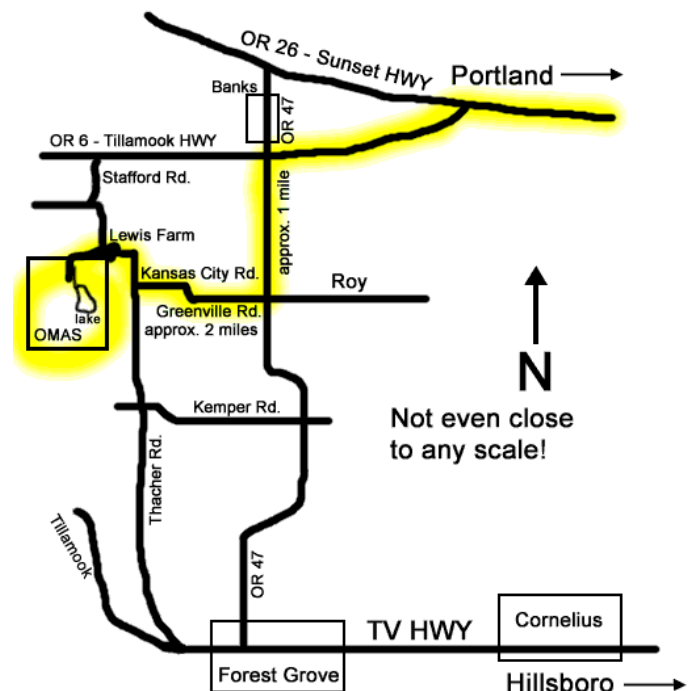
No October Newsletter
